



Summary

The Kellyville United Football Club Privacy Policy explains how the club collects, uses, holds, and protects personal information in accordance with relevant privacy laws. It outlines what constitutes personal information, what types of personal details are collected (such as name, contact details, date of birth, gender, and emergency contacts), and the importance the club places on maintaining privacy and data security for everyone involved.

Kellyville United Football Club Privacy Policy

Kellyville United Football Club (KUFC) values and respects the privacy of the people we deal with. KUFC is committed to protecting your privacy and complying with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth), the Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998 (NSW), and other applicable privacy laws and regulations. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, hold, use and disclose your personal information, and how we maintain the quality and security of that information.

What is personal information?

Personal information is any information or opinion, whether true or not, and whether recorded in a material form or not, about an identified individual or an individual who is reasonably identifiable. This includes information that identifies you directly or indirectly.

What personal information do we collect?

The personal information we collect depends on your interaction with the Club. This information is generally collected through registration to participate in football activities and via Football NSW systems. It may include:

- Name, address, phone number and email address
- Date of birth and gender
- Emergency contact details
- Education, occupation and employment history (where relevant)
- Coaching, refereeing or accreditation details
- Disciplinary history (where applicable)
- Identification documents (e.g. driver's licence, birth certificate, visa details)
- Working With Children Check (WWCC) number and status
- Social media details where provided

Sensitive information is collected only where necessary for participation in football activities and is handled in accordance with Football NSW privacy requirements.

How we collect personal information

We collect personal information directly from you when you:

- Register to play or volunteer via Football NSW platforms
- Communicate with us by phone, email or in person



- Interact with us online
- Attend Club events or activities
- Apply for a role as an employee, contractor or volunteer

We may also collect personal information from third parties such as Football NSW to support registration, grading, team allocation and administration of football activities.

How we use your personal information

We use personal information to:

- Administer registrations, grading and team placements
- Communicate important information about fixtures, events and activities
- Respond to enquiries and provide services
- Meet legal and regulatory obligations
- Improve our services and Club operations
- Conduct marketing communications where consent has been provided

Disclosure of personal information

We may disclose personal information to:

- Football NSW and affiliated governing bodies
- Referees and officials sanctioned by Football NSW
- Emergency services such as NSW Ambulance Service
- NSW Police Force where required by law
- Other parties where disclosure is authorised or required by law

How we protect your personal information

KUFC takes reasonable steps to protect personal information from misuse, loss and unauthorised access. This includes:

- Restricted access to information on a need-to-know basis
- Secure storage of physical and electronic records
- Use of appropriate technical safeguards such as passwords and security software

Online activity

Our website may use cookies to enhance your browsing experience and analyse website traffic. Cookies do not identify you personally. You can manage cookie settings through your browser; however, disabling cookies may affect website functionality.

Direct marketing

We may send communications about Club activities, opportunities or events where you have consented. You may opt out at any time by following the unsubscribe instructions or contacting us directly.

Retention of personal information

We retain personal information only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes outlined in this Policy or as required by law.
